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### **ALLEN C. HASKELL (1935-2004)**

Allen Clifton Haskell, a lifelong resident of New Bedford, Massachusetts, was born 11 May 1935 to Allen Watson Haskell, Jr. (1913-1990) and Iantha P. Miller (1917-2002). He graduated from Bristol Agricultural School in 1953. He grew up near the former Hathaway Farm, purchased in 1938 by Albert Winterbottom, Treasurer of Old Booth Mill. The Winterbottom Family ran a farm and small dairy on New Bedford property. Haskell often visited the farm, prior to 1954, and took art lessons from Louise Beech who lived next door.

In 1954, Haskell founded his nursery, Allen C. Haskell Horticulturalists, Inc. (also known as Allen C. Haskell and Son Nursery) on the grounds of the former Hathaway Farm. Around 1968, he purchased the property and began restoring the main house, known as the Hathaway House, which dates from 1725, making it the oldest house in New Bedford.

The property served as a showcase for the Nursery. On the 6-acre property were seasonal plants, topiaries, and 30,000 square feet of greenhouses. Haskell and his staff, many of them family

members, developed a bird habitat and added additional buildings for his hens, pheasants, pigeons and other birds. He showed his fowl at the New England Bantam Club. In addition to the New Bedford location, the Nursery ran a 50-acre farm in Fairhaven, MA, where Highland cattle, camels and emus were kept.

Nursery clients included Jacqueline Kennedy Onassis and Queen Beatrix of the Netherlands. Allen C. Haskell also appeared on Martha Stewart's television show. In New Bedford, the Nursery designed gardens for the Whaling Museum, The Rotch-Jones Duff Museum, and Buttonwood Park. The Nursery also built and maintained the gardens at the Chestnut Hill shopping mall.

Haskell became involved in the New England Flower Show when he assisted Marinus Vander Pol in installing an exhibit in the 1950s. The Nursery soon began producing an annual exhibit, taking many of the top prizes. The Massachusetts Horticultural Society eventually named an award for Haskell.

As a horticulturalist, Haskell was also noted for his trained topiaries and his hosta collection. He worked with hosta hybrid specialist Mildred Seever of Dedham, Massachusetts and exhibited over 47 varieties of hostas; he also cultivated 40 varieties of ivies. Haskell used a variety of landscape traditions, including English, French, and Japanese gardening styles.

Haskell died on 7 December 2004. According to his *New York Times* obituary, he was survived by his wife, Ellena Brightman Haskell, of Fairhaven, Massachusetts; a son, David Allen Haskell, of New Bedford, Massachusetts; two daughters, Rebecca Akers, of West Fargo, North Dakota and Felicia Cruz, of New Bedford, Massachusetts; a sister, Nancy Rua, of Florida; ten grandchildren; and Eugene J. Bertrand Jr.

## **DESCRIPTION OF THE PAPERS**

The Allen C. Haskell Papers document the horticultural career of Allen C. Haskell. The papers, which span the years 1949 to 2009, emphasize the daily business of running a nursery. The bulk of the material consists of the financial records of the Nursery dating from 1990 to 2002. The papers are organized into nine series: Correspondence, Written Material, Printed Material, Legal Documents and Financial Records, Landscape Architectural Plans, Prints, Seeds, Library, and Photographs. At the end of the finding aid there is a description of related objects and books owned by The Trustees of Reservations. The Trustees of Reservations also has an additional collection of 133 digital images shared by Eugene J. Bertrand Jr.

Series I, Correspondence, is organized into two subseries: Letters and Invitations. The first subseries, Letters, consists of letters to Haskell.

The second subseries, Invitations, consists of invitations received by Haskell.

Series II, Written Material, includes notes of household expenses, furniture labels, and a pathway plan.

Series III, Printed Material, is organized into two subseries: Certificates, and Newspaper Articles. The first subseries, Certificates, includes a certificate from the City of New Bedford signifying that Haskell completed his studies at the New Bedford Elementary Schools.

The second subseries, Newspaper Articles, includes newspaper articles about Allen C. Haskell.

Series IV, Legal Documents and Financial Records, is organized into seven subseries: Legal Documents, Tax and License Notices, Nursery Financial Records, Bank Statements, Utility Bills, Nursery Bills and Receipts, and Plant Order Records. The first subseries, Legal Documents, consists of a petition by Allen C. Haskell and Ellena Brightman Haskell for custody of Joan Carol Haskell (1940-2003), sister of Allen C. Haskell.

The second subseries, Tax and License Notices, consists of notices from the government and compliance organizations.

The third subseries, Nursery Financial Records, consists of documents relating to taxes and employee wages.

The fourth subseries, Bank Statements, consists of bank statements and transaction receipts from Compass Bank, Fleet Bank, and New Bedford Institution for Savings.

The fifth subseries, Utility Bills, includes bills for garbage pickup and cellular telephone service.

The sixth subseries, Nursery Bills and Receipts, consists of bills and receipts related to the daily business of the Nursery.

The seventh subseries, Plant Order Records, consists of documents related to plants ordered by the Nursery for resale.

Series V, Landscape Architecture Plans, consists of landscape plans designed by both Allen C. Haskell and his son, David Haskell. Titles of the plans are indicated by italics.

Series VI, Prints, includes bird prints and a Mardi Gras event print.

Series VII, Seeds, consists of four small packets of seeds.

Series VIII, Library, is organized into four subseries: Organization Publications, Brochures, Price Lists and Catalogs, and Magazines. The first subseries, Organization Publications, includes publications by The Arnold Arboretum and the Massachusetts Horticultural Society.

The second subseries, Brochures, includes publications about exhibits.

The third subseries, Price Lists and Catalogs, includes publications by seed companies.

The fourth subseries, Magazines, includes gardening and antiques magazines.

Series, IX, Photographs, is organized into three subseries: Photographic Prints, John Havens Thornton Photographs, and Digital Photographs. The first subseries, Photographic Prints, includes photographs of flower show exhibits, and photographs of individual plants. The prints are identified by subject.

The second subseries, John Havens Thornton Photographs, consists of photographs by New Bedford Photographer John Havens Thornton of the Nursery. The prints are identified by subject.

The third subseries, Digital Photographs, consists of digital photographs in which the people and/or locations were identified by Eugene J. Bertrand Jr. in 2014. The photographs are identified by subject. These files are stored electronically.

The Trustees of Reservations holds additional materials related to the Allen C. Haskell Papers. These materials are listed in two series, Books, and Certificates.

Series I, Books, consist of books that that were collected by Allen C. Haskell. They are listed by author.

Series II, Certificates, consists of certificates awarded to Allen C. Haskell and his Nursery. The certificates are listed by granting organization and located offsite. The text presented on the certificates is written within quotation marks.
