Oriental bittersweet

Celastrus orbiculatus

Unwanted for: Infesting forest gaps & open areas, strangling trees & causing branches to break due to weight, genetic swamping of native bittersweet

Plant Type: Perennial vine with round to oval leaves and flower clusters along the vine. Native to Asia

What you can do:

- Hand pull or dig seedlings
- Cut large vines and apply herbicide
- Prevent spread by not moving infested soil or fill
- Do not use showy berries in decoration
