Polygonum cuspidatum

Unwanted for: Infesting riverbanks & disturbed areas, displacing native plants, reducing wildlife habitat

Plant Type: Perennial with hollow bamboo-like stems up to 10' tall. Plants spread by sending shoots up from underground runners, Native to East Asia

What you can do:

- Dig early in the spring and remove
- Mow or cut several times through growing season to prevent flowering & seed production
- Prevent spread by not moving infested soil or fill
