What is a CSA?

Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) is a program that connects you (the shareholder) to your local farmer.

HOW IT WORKS:

You buy a 'share' of the farm's vegetable/fruit production for a 20-week growing season, and then you come every week to pick up your box of fresh goodies on a specific day. Buying a CSA share means you get access to a great supply of the freshest, most delicious produce all season long!

What's in a share?

Almost every week you'll get different veggies in your share as the late spring winds into summer and then into fall. Every vegetable has its season, and we plant successions to make some favorites last longer. This is seasonal eating at its best! We have a broad range of vegetables including all of your old favorites, but plenty of new and interesting vegetables, too.

Our large share size is a healthy weekly amount of vegetables for a family of 4-6. We offer a limited number of small shares if you have a smaller family or a home garden (2-3 people).

WHAT IS THE COST OF A SHARE?

Shares cost \$650 for a large share and \$450 for a small share for the full 20-week season. *You must be a member of the Trustees through the season.*

Pick Your Own Garden

Your share also comes with access to our pick-your-own gardens. These gardens are filled with a selection of vegetables, flowers and fruits that we open up to our shareholders to pick themselves. (Kids love helping with this!)

Our gardens include: cherry tomatoes, green and wax beans, fava beans, peas (snow, sugar snap, and shelling), tomatillos, edamame soybean, herbs (basil, cilantro, parsley, dill, oregano, and thyme), cut flowers and more!


