## Visitor Tips

- Alcohol is not permitted.
- Dress appropriately. Wear sandals or sneakers and a windbreaker under windy conditions.
- Sun block, sunglasses, and insect repellent are recommended.
- You are traveling to remote locations; medical and emergency facilities are not available. However, all tour vehicles carry two-way radios.
- Restrooms are located at the Mytoi Garden parking area, Dike Bridge gatehouse, Cape Poge Lighthouse, Wasque gatehouse, and the visitor center at Long Point Wildlife Refuge.

## Cancellation Policy

Make reservations early. Registrants will be called if a tour is canceled due to weather or other causes. Pre-registrants who cancel should call 508.627.3599 (Cape Poge tours) or 508.693.7392 (Long Point tours) as soon as possible to ensure that those on waiting lists may be contacted.

**Natural History Tour**  
Daily, May – November | 9AM & 1:30PM  
(TOUR DURATION: 3 HOURS)

Relax and enjoy the extensive birding, beachcombing, and photographic moments this tour has to offer as you travel to the farthest reaches of Cape Poge Wildlife Refuge and Wasque Reservation via oversand vehicle. Your journey includes a stop at the Cape Poge Lighthouse.

Take in the natural beauty of legendary fishing beaches like Wasque Point and The Gut, learn the art of surfcasting, and try your luck at catching salt-water finfish like striped bass, bluefish, and false albacore. Enjoy a guided oversand vehicle tour of Cape Poge Wildlife Refuge, discover the intriguing stories of lightkeepers who watched over these waters for nearly 150 years, and climb the century-old lighthouse for breathtaking views of Martha's Vineyard. This tour is perfect for explorers of all ages.

**Wildlife Kayak Tour**  
Daily, June – Sept. | 10AM & 2:30PM (TOUR DURATION: 2.5 HOURS)
