Visitor Tips

- Restrooms are located at the Mytoi Garden parking area, Dike Bridge gatehouse, Cape Poge Lighthouse, Wasque gatehouse, and the visitor center at Long Point Wildlife Refuge.
- Kayak tour participants may get wet, please dress accordingly
