



## Simple Wedding Property Use Agreement At Doyle Community Park

The property is owned and managed by The Trustees of Reservations, a member-supported nonprofit conservation organization that preserves, for public use and enjoyment, properties of exceptional scenic, historic, and ecological value in Massachusetts, and works to protect special places across the state. Doyle Community Park is available for simple wedding ceremonies. However, in order to provide the best possible experience and avoid conflicts with other visitors to the property, the following guidelines must be followed:

1. Whenever a client wishes to hold a simple wedding ceremony/wedding photos and would like to use Doyle Community Park as a setting, the User must first pay a Simple Wedding fee and sign a Property Use Agreement, prior to using the property.
2. Rates depend on day of the week. Fees are for very simple wedding ceremonies which fall under the person limit below without tables, chairs etc. and does not entitle the User to any other use of the grounds without permission:
  - Friday, Saturday or Sunday: \$75 1<sup>st</sup> hour; \$25 for each additional hour
  - Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday: \$50 1<sup>st</sup> hour; \$25 each additional hour

*NOTE: Members receive 20% off. Please call 978.840.4446 x1921 to purchase a membership.*
3. No more than 20 people (not including a photographer) may attend the wedding ceremony. *Over 20 people will require staff presence and an additional payment.*
4. The User is not entitled to exclusive use of the property. **The grounds will remain open to the public.** Exclusive use of designated areas *may* be granted for an additional fee.
5. Considerations of public safety and the protection of the man made and natural resources at the Doyle Community Park shall have absolute preference over any of the User's activities. The Trustees of Reservations reserves the right to monitor all of the User's activities and prohibit any use that it deems to be in conflict with Doyle Community Park and/or The Trustees operating policies, including but not limited to:
  - Conduct which disturbs the tranquility of the property or its enjoyment by others is prohibited
  - Littering is prohibited. Please carry out anything you carry in.
  - Cutting or removing vegetation is prohibited.
  - Alcoholic Beverages are not permitted on the property at any time.
  - Nudity is prohibited.
  - Parking on lawns is prohibited
6. User shall be responsible for all of the actions and activities of their party. The User agrees to assume all liability for any property or personal damage resulting from their use of the property. The User shall hold the Trustees of Reservations harmless for any loss, injury, damage or expense arising out of his/her use of the property.
7. The client and guests shall park in the visitor parking area provided on Abbott Street (Doyle Conservation Center Parking Lot). **One** vehicle may be permitted to park at the Estate if this is where ceremony is scheduled to take place – please notify staff if this is required. Also, arrangements can be made for handicapped parking.
8. The availability of the Doyle Community Park as a venue for a wedding ceremony is on a first come, first served basis, based on receipt of check. In the event of rain, you will have an opportunity to a rescheduled date or cancellation of reservation.

After reading the above Simple Wedding Property Use Agreement, please fill out the following form and return it with a check in order to book your wedding ceremony. Please provided at least 30-day lead-time, we will do our best to contact you to confirm your booking.
