VISITOR TIPS

- Alcohol is not permitted.
- Sunblock, sunglasses and insect repellent are recommended.
- Bring snacks and water; these are remote locations with no convenience stores or vending machines.
- Dress appropriately. Wear comfortable sandals or sneakers. Weather conditions can change rapidly; wear appropriate layers for windy and wet conditions.
- Kayak and Explore the Shore participants **will** get wet; please dress accordingly!
- Portable toilets are located at the Mytoi Garden parking area, Dike Bridge gatehouse, Cape Poge lighthouse, Wasque gatehouse, Wasque beaches and the visitor center at Long Point Wildlife Refuge.
- Participants must be aware that emergency medical facilities are not available in these remote locations. All tour guides carry two-way radios.
- Registration is recommended (and in some cases, required) for all tours. Walk-on space may not be available – please call ahead!

CANCELLATION POLICY

Make reservations early. Registrants will be called if a tour is cancelled due to weather or other causes. Pre-registrants needing to cancel should call 508.627.3599 (Cape Poge tours) or 508.693.7392 (Long Point tours) as soon as possible to ensure that those on waiting lists may be contacted.

SPECIALTY TOURS AT CAPE POGE

Cape Poge Lighthouse Tour | 1.5 Hours

Daily, Memorial Day–Columbus Day | 10:30AM & 1PM & 3PM
Sit back and enjoy a guided over-sand vehicle ride to the remote Cape Poge Lighthouse. Climb the lighthouse's spiral staircase and discover intriguing stories of the keepers of the light. This tour is great for explorers of all ages. Tours fill quickly; pre-registration strongly suggested.

Wildlife Discovery Kayak Tour | 2 Hours

Daily, July 1–Labor Day | 10AM & 2PM
Cape Poge is home to a variety of wildlife. With a Trustees' naturalist as a guide, you will explore the beauty of the salt water world from the perfect vantage point: a kayak or canoe! Weather permitting. Children under 15 must paddle with an adult. Tours fill quickly; pre-registration strongly suggested.

Kayak & Stand Up Paddleboard Rentals

Discover the tranquil waters and natural history of Long Point as you paddle through Long Cove Pond on a self-guided tour. Rentals are available on the western side of Long Cove Pond and are provided on a first-come, first-served basis.
Kayaks: MEMBERS: Single boat \$20/hour; double boat \$30/hour. NONMEMBERS: Single boat \$30/hour; double boat \$40/hour.
Paddleboards: MEMBERS: \$20/hour. NONMEMBERS: \$25/hour.

Yoga on the Beach | 1.5 hours

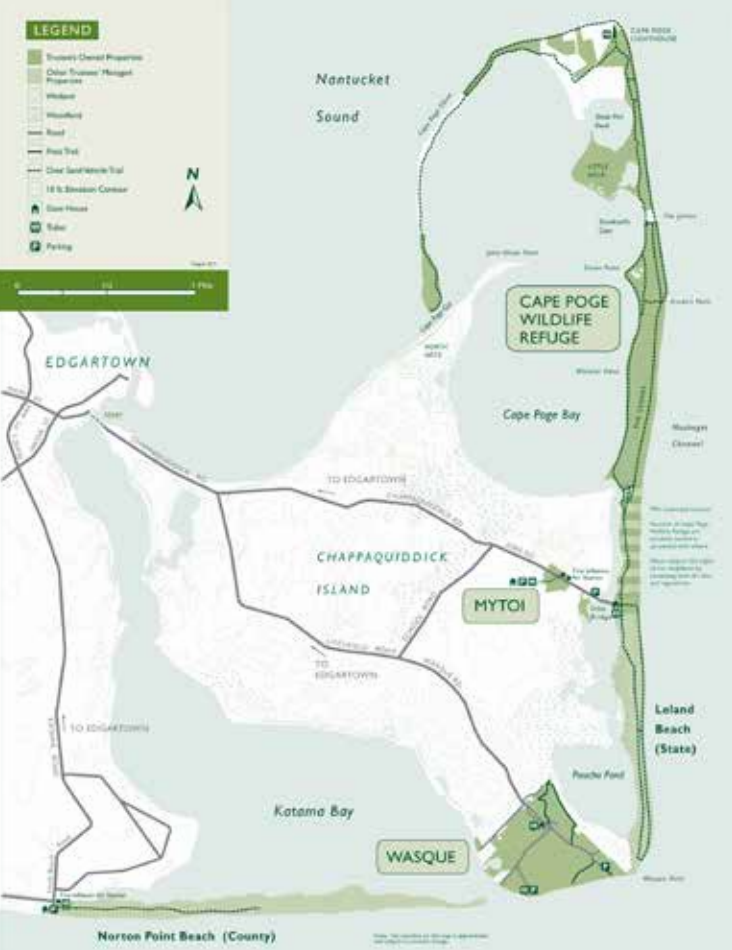
Wednesdays, July & August | 5:30PM | Long Point
