Bush Honeysuckle

Lonicera morrowii, tartarica, x bella, maackii

Unwanted for: Infesting forested and open areas, displacing native plants, reducing wildlife habitat

Plant Type: Shrub with opposite oval leaves; bark is tan to gray and shreds; flowers are tubular white, yellow or pink; cut stems are hollow; fruits are red to orange, juicy and abundant. Native to Asia

What you can do:

- Uproot plants by hand-pulling or digging
- Cut repeatedly or use herbicide
- Prevent spread by not moving infested soil or fill
