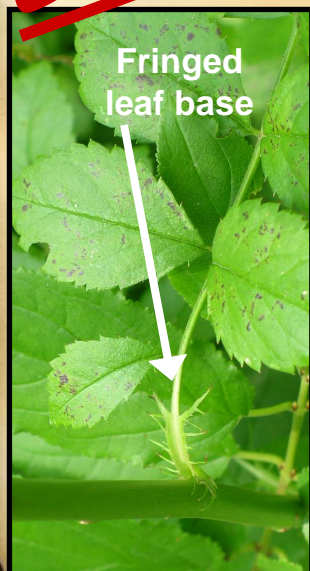

Multiflora rose

Rosa multiflora

Unwanted for: Forming dense thickets and crowding out native species. Infesting pastures and old fields.

Plant Type: A shrub with arching stems and stiff, curved thorns. Dense clusters of white flowers develop into very small red rose hips. Native to Eastern Asia.

What you can do:

- Hand pull small plants and roots.
- Mow or cut several times through growing season to limit top growth or spread.
- Apply herbicide.
